THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BEAVER TOWNSHIP, Mahoning County, Ohio meeting in Regular Session on Tuesday, May 7, 1996 did adopt the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 505.89 provides that the Board of Township Trustees may adopt a curfew for persons under 18 years of age in unincorporated areas of the township.

WHEREAS, the BEAVER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES does deem it necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in Beaver Township, that such curfew be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the BEAVER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES, that no minor in Beaver Township, Mahoning County, State of Ohio, under the age of 18 years, shall be present, loiter, idle, wander, stroll or play in or upon the public streets, places of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots, or any other private property, or unsupervised places between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. local time. However, the provisions of the section do not apply to a minor under 18 years of age accompanied by his or her parent, guardian, or other adult person over 21 years of age having the care and custody of the minor, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed by his or her parent, guardian, or other adult person over 21 years of age having the care and custody of the minor.

Special consideration will be given to any school, church, lodge or other organization sponsored functions wherein minors under 18 years of age will be in attendance and cause the minor under 18 years of age to be out later than 11:00 P.M. local time. The time during which such special consideration will be granted will not be later than 12:30 A.M. local time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the BEAVER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES that this Resolution shall become effective immediately on this 7th day of May, 1996.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be enforced by all law enforcement officers having jurisdiction within Beaver Township, including but not limited to the Beaver Township Police Constables and Deputies of the Mahoning County Sheriff.
