### Beaver Township NEW Interchange I-680/SR 164 Project

Work has begun on a brand new interchange in Beaver Township. Over the next two years, a "roundabout" will be constructed on SR 164. This \$11.6 million dollar state funded project will be completed in November 2019. This project will also include our first "park and ride". ### Meet Lucas! Our Newest EMS gift!



Lucas device is an acronym that stands for Lund University CPR Assist Device. The Lucas was designed, built and tested at Lund University in Sweden. The newest generation of this machine is now on the Beaver Township Ambulance. This machine provides mechanical CPR in the event a patient suffers cardiac arrest (stoppage of the heart). It is an easy-to-use device that does its job perfectly. The Lucas takes over the job of CPR compressor that was once done by an EMT (Emergency Medical Technician). That EMT is now free to do other tasks associated with reviving someone in cardiac arrest.

The Lucas is high tech. It uses a computer to provide very precise CPR to the patient. It runs off a rechargeable battery, or can even be plugged into an AC outlet. It is simple in design and can be used effectively with a smaller amount of personnel. It is portable and can be carried into any environment where it is needed. It never gets tired of doing CPR, it doesn't complain, it doesn't forget, it is always at the ready regardless of the time of day or circumstances.

Many Beaver Township residents do not realize that BTFD is a volunteer Fire/EMS department. Almost all of the firefighters and EMT's have full time jobs in addition to their first responder duties. The Lucas gives us an extra hand when we need it the most. Of course, we are always ready to welcome new members to our department too (Call 330-549-2133 if you may be interested in serving your community as a firefighter/EMT).

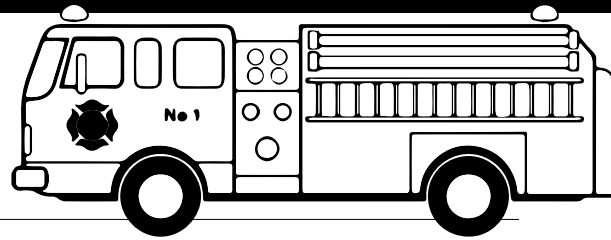
This device is expensive. Our current Lucas cost \$15,000.00. It was bought and paid for, and then donated to the township by the Beaver Township Firemen's Association. Many years of chicken dinners, spaghetti dinners, pancake breakfasts, and CPR classes were needed to raise funds for this machine. Although all Beaver Township taxpayers will benefit from this machine, no tax money was used to purchase it.

We have used this machine many times since its purchase. It has proven to be a very effective machine. Our experience with it in the field has been overwhelmingly positive as well. It is a great addition to our emergency medical equipment.

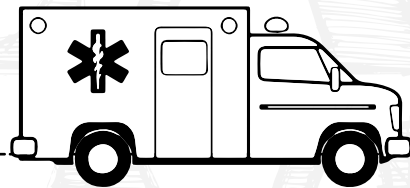

### POLICE DOG AND BEN ROETHLISBERGER FOUNDATION

As 2017 drew to a close, the Police Department began preparation to replace PSD Hero, who is turning 8 years old. At the same time, Brian Woods, the kennel owner we have used for all of our dogs, notified us that he was planning to retire and close. Brian is a retired Police Sergeant from Fremont (Ohio) PD. Seeing the burning desire within Officer Chris Albert during his training with PSD Hero, he asked Albert if he would consider taking the training necessary for him to become a dog trainer, instead of just a dog handler. Woods presented us with an amazing offer, which included the cost of a new dog and all the necessary training for the dog and for Albert himself. The training will allow Albert to source our future dogs and fully train and maintain them. It also will allow us to offer his assistance to our neighboring police agencies.

Albert began researching grants in an attempt to at least offset the anticipated \$13,500 it would cost for the dog and training. He made an application with the Ben Roethlisberger Foundation, who provides up to \$10,000 grants to police departments in the Pittsburgh area for police service dog programs. In February 2018, we were notified that Roethlisberger loved the idea that this request would help not only Beaver PD, but also other agencies in our area and they agreed to provide the entire \$13,500!

In March 2018, Woods and Albert picked out our new dog, PSD Argo. Argo is only 14 months old and was brought to the United States from the Czech Republic. He will undergo 10 weeks of intensive training and then will be sworn in as a police officer with Beaver PD after he receives his certification from the State of Ohio.
