The bid books will be reviewed by the Fire Department Truck Committee.

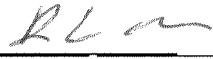
Megan from ODNR called and would like to trap raccoons at Woodworth Park, in the woods only, to vaccinate for rabies.

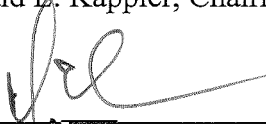
There was discussion concerning senior facility language in the zoning resolution book.

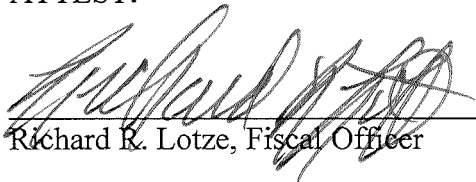
